FINAL MUSICAL INFORMATION LETTER

Dear Parents/Caregivers

- Remember next Monday 12 September and Tuesday 13 September, is when the students travel out to Highfields Cultural Centre for their practices for our School Musical. Children will leave FHSS at 8.45am SHARP and return by 3.00pm.
- Permission and payment for the bus was due Monday 5 September. If you have not paid please do so immediately.
- Children need to bring their Morning Tea, Lunch and water bottle with them. Tuesday is a full dress rehearsal.
- Don't forget to purchase your tickets – as of today we have 150 tickets left for the evening performance and 50 for the 11am performance!

Musical Performances – Morning @ 11am & Evening @ 7pm

For the Morning Performance on Thursday 15 September, children will meet at 8.30 am in Shed 2 for a Roll call and leave Fairview Heights at 8.45am SHARP

Thursday 11am Performance

Students will be transported to and from Highfields Cultural Centre by bus.

- They need to bring a drink bottle and Morning Tea.
- Please have clean hair, clean face and **NO JEWELLERY**.
- Under the student's makeup we will be using sorbelene cream as a base. If your child is allergic to this, could you send an alternative cream along with your child. Thank you.
- They will need to have their basic makeup applied once they have changed into their costumes for the Morning Performance at 11.00am.
- The bus will return the Musical Children back to the school by 1.15pm to have their lunch.
- Children in the Musical need to keep their Makeup on, even when they have a shower at home before the Evening Performance – Do not wash your child's face. Therefore we will only need to Touch Up and enhance their basic makeup for the Evening Performance.
- No child has to provide costumes. We have had some students inquire about footwear on stage. Children in the Dancing Chorus **DO NOT WEAR FOOTWEAR**. If they are wearing socks, they will be provided by the school. Main Characters have been told what to bring.
- All female dancers need to have their **HAIR IN A LOW PONYTAIL ON THE RIGHT SIDE**.
- All girls who are mermaids need to wear beige underwear as their costumes require this.

Thursday 7pm Performance

Students need to be transported to and from Highfields Cultural Centre by Parents/Carers.

- Children need to be at Highfields Cultural Centre at the given time for their make-up/face painting for the evening performance as stated below.

- They will need to bring a drink bottle and something to eat for tea before their make-up/face painting time slot. **NO EATING** after make-up/faces have been painted/touched up.
- After the show - Parents please wait in the foyer and students will come out to you after they have changed. Otherwise, there are too many people in a confined space and costumes become mixed up amongst the excitement.
